In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, Good Shepherd Teacher Training Institute, No. 5, Radhakrishna Street, Charles Nagar, Pattabhiram, Chennai – 600 072, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Elementary(D.T.Ed) Course of two years from the academic session 2005 – 06.

- 2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
 - a The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b. The institution will ensure that the permanent building is constructed within a period of 3 years on the acquired land.
 - c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3.00 lakhs.
 - d. The institution has selected the Principal and Five teachers for the said course.
- Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Good Shepherd Teacher Training Institute, No. 5, Radhakrishna Street, Charles Nagar, Pattabhiram, Chennai 600 072, Tamilnadu to offer Elementary(D.T.Ed) course of two years duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 50 students, subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a. The institution will ensure that Six exclusive faculty members (Principal and Five teachers) duly approved by the DTERT are in position for an intake of 50 students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of admissions for the course.
 - b. The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
 - c. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
